Artistic Expressions

- 1. "Caught in Kindness" Jar Set up a jar where students can write down acts of kindness they witness or experience and read them aloud during class meetings. The student who displays an act of kindness can receive a "Caught in Kindness" sticker (or another prize). Keep a list of all the students and the number of kind acts they perform throughout the year.
- 2. **Kindness Tree** On the bulletin board on a wall, build a "Kindness Tree". The branches can represent all the different acts of kindness students can perform at school, home, or in their community.
- 3. **Kindness Challenge Board** Create a bulletin board with kindness challenges for students to complete, such as smiling at someone new or helping a classmate with their work.
